District Fee Schedule For Operating Year 2026-2027

EXEMPT WELLS:

Exempt wells are those utilized for private Residential and Agriculture wells. **No Fees**

1. All Exempt wells must have a Registration Application filled out and a registration number assigned before drilling.
2. All wells must have the State of Texas Well Report filed and verifiable with TDLR within 60 days of completion of the well. (Well Drillers Responsibility).

1 to 5 inches	\$300.00
6 to 9 inches	\$500.00
10 inches +	\$1,000.00

Annual Operating Permit:
(issued for 3yr terms only)

Well Casing Size (Inside Diameter)

1 to 5 inches	\$200.00 per year
6 to 9 inches	\$400.00 per year
10 inches +	\$800.00 per year

Quarterly Pumpage Late Reporting Fee per Month, per Well \$100.00

Pumping Production Fee per thousand gallons. \$0.050

Permit Amendment \$100.00

Export Fee out of the District is based on per thousand gallons \$0.020
Annual Export application Fee (3 years) \$1,000.00 per year

Application Review Fee (actual cost) \$TBD

The actual fee charged is the cost of consultants the District engages to assist in the scientific, legal or other professional experts review and the cost of official required publications for public hearings if required.

Effective August 1, 2026. All permit fees and production fees apply to new permits issued on or after this date. Existing production permits will transition to the revised production fee upon renewal during the 2027-2028 renewal cycle.
